

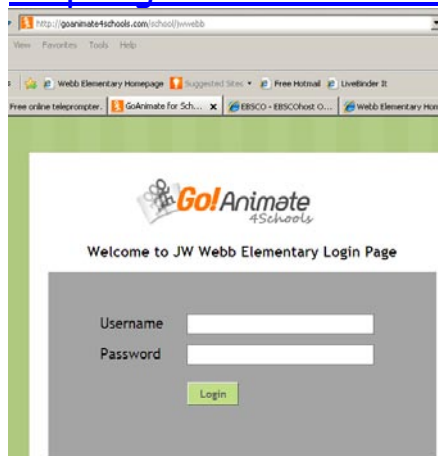

Technology Instruction Page



Go Animate is an easy to use animation tool where teachers and students can create animated stories using the already created studio. You can upload pictures, add your own voice, or use those already in the studio. This is a controlled environment and a wonderful and fun way for students to tell a story.

The first thing you need to do is log on. You can go to:
www.gonaimate.com for the basic account which has limitations,
or you can go into our school account at:

Once logged in, go to the top left corner and select lesson gallery. Then in the top corner, choose go to private section.



Click on create. Then choose tutorial. This will walk you thru a detailed tutorial to show you how to add backgrounds, characters, choose voices, animations, and everything you need to work and create your project. Once your tutorial is complete, you will be in the process of creating your first project. You can continue with what you have started, or go back into your scenes and change them if you would like.



The lil' peepz option allows you to choose more options. The top row is where all of your options are to create. Down at the bottom is where you add scenes. Remember that each scene can only have 1 character speaking. Be sure to save and you can always come back and edit your work later so just don't publish until you are finished. You can also create your own characters and much more. Your students will love using this tool.
