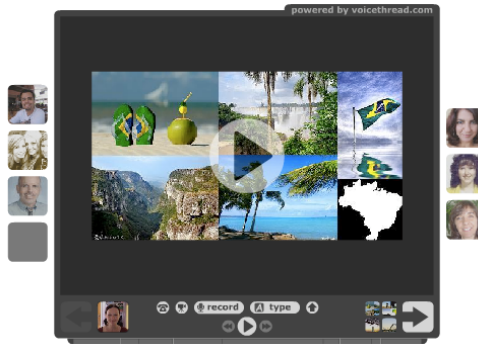

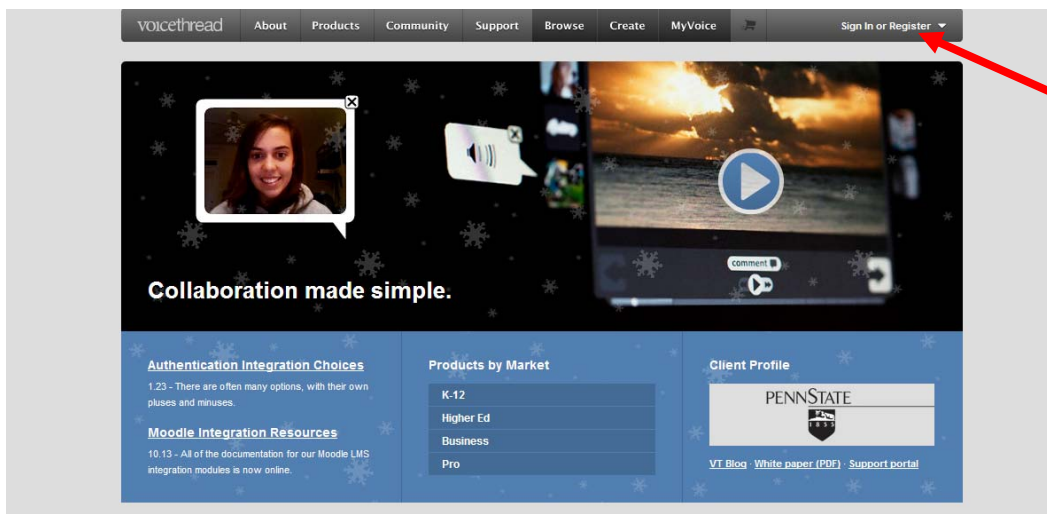


## VoiceThread

With VoiceThread, group conversations are collected and shared in one place from anywhere in the world.


A VoiceThread is a collaborative, multimedia slide show that holds images, documents, and videos and allows people to navigate pages and leave comments in 5 ways - using voice (with a mic or telephone), text, audio file, or video (via a webcam).

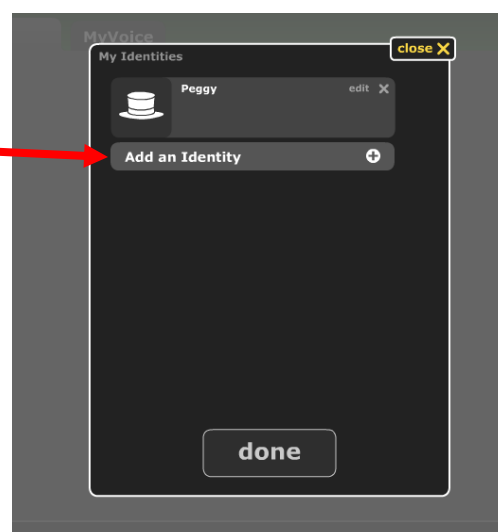
Once you are logged in, click on "Create."



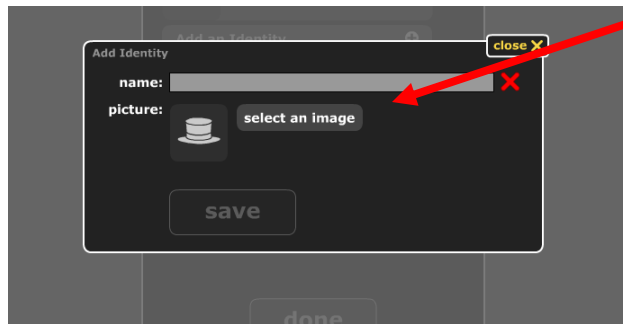
Click the down arrow next to your account name and then click on "My Identities." This is where you can add your students (up to 100) and their pictures. You can use an icon or an avatar instead of a student picture if you would like.



Click on "Add Identity."



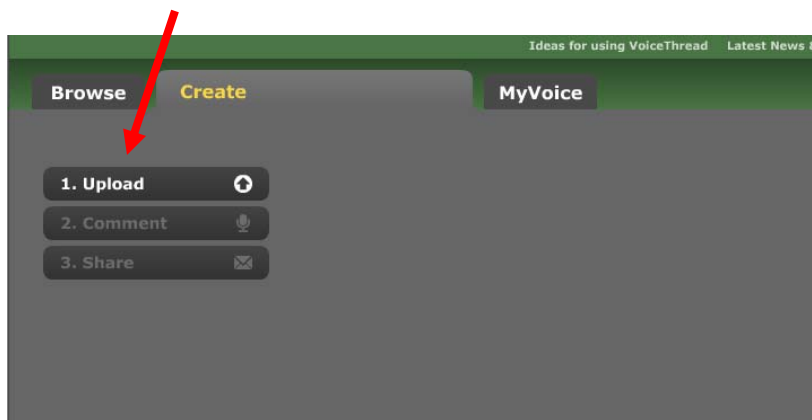
Enter the students name and click on "Select an Image."



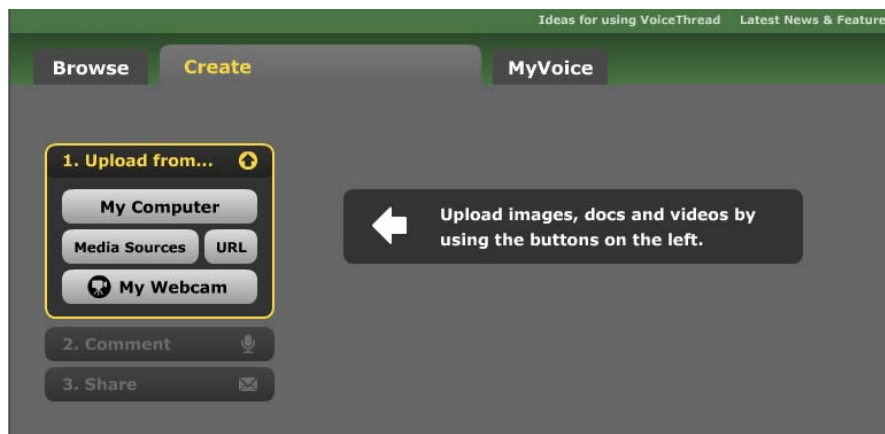
Upload a picture or image for that student.  
Click "Save" and enter the rest of your students. When finished, click "Close X" and then "Done" on the following screen.

Now you are ready to upload student images for your VoiceThread. Based on your curricular needs, have each student or groups of students create an image to use for the VoiceThread and save it on their shared drive or to a flash drive (or whatever is easiest for you to retrieve).

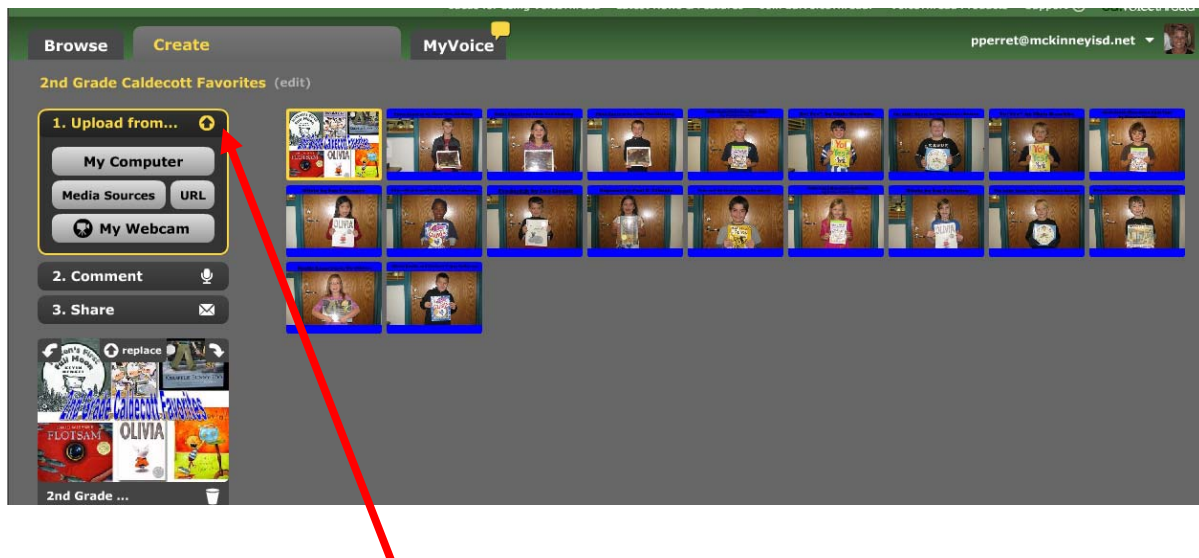
Click on "Upload."



Follow the screen directions and navigate to where your students have saved their images and upload them to your VoiceThread.



Once you have finished uploading all of your images, save your VoiceThread and give it a title or name.

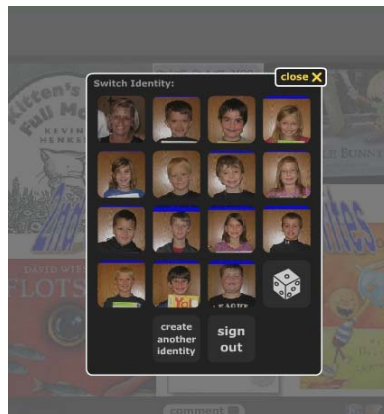


Now you are ready to have students begin commenting on their page and one other page. Click the yellow arrow to close the upload window.

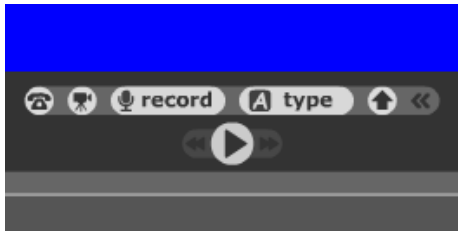


Click on the "Comment" button and then navigate to the correct page to make a comment by using the arrow button in the right hand corner.

Next, click on the "picture" icon in the bottom left hand corner and then navigate to the correct person who will be commenting.

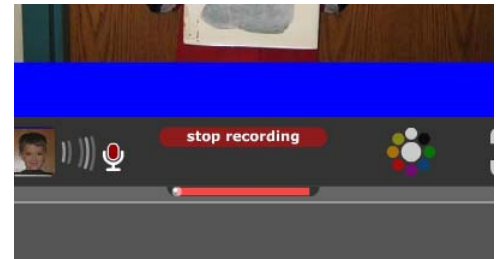


This puts the correct student in the left hand corner for commenting. Next, click on the comment button at the bottom.



Click "record" and begin speaking into the microphone.

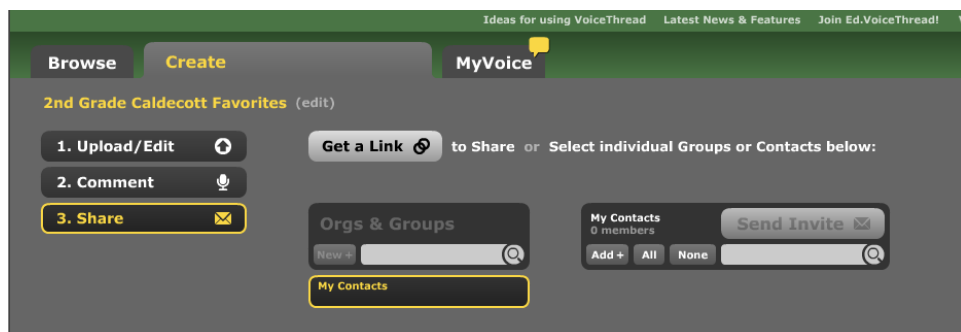
Click on "Stop Recording" when finished.



Finally, click on "Save" or "Cancel" to try again.



Once your project is finished, click on "Share" and email an invite to your tech rep or LMS and any parents you would like to view your finished project.



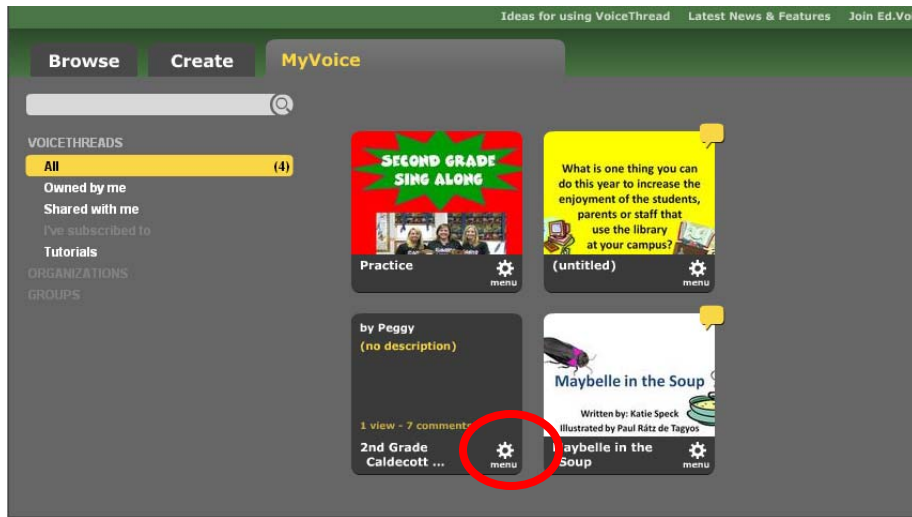
Any project can be saved and edited at a later time.

Once you are logged back into your account, click on the "MyVoice" tab and you can see your projects. If you hover over



the project you want to edit you will see a "menu" button on the lower right hand corner.

Click on the menu button and then click on "edit." This will take you back to your project so you can edit.



Once students have commented on their own page, have them choose another student's page (or group's page) and make a comment on it as well.

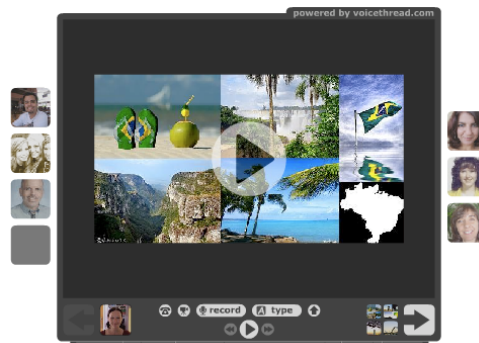
