




Dabbleboard

Dabbleboard is an online whiteboard that will help you visualize, explore and communicate ideas.

1. Type in www.dabbleboard.com. This website is free, but you can register to sign up to save your drawings. This will be your choice!
2. Click on the "Take the Tour" blue button. Once the new screen comes up, click on the arrow to play the video. It will be a brief explanation about the uses of the toolbar.
3. After viewing the video about Dabbleboard, click on "Draw".




4. This is the screen where you will create your drawings.




5. The next screen is filled with helpful hints for producing drawings. You can use the "clipboard" button to start a new drawing.


6. You can click on the blue "Drawing" to find more features that you could use in your drawing.




- Click on "Share and Chat" button so that the drawing can be shared with another user. A new window will open up so then click on "Invite Others". This will open up a window that shows the link to the drawing which will be copied and saved in the clipboard. In the email drawing link, type in the email address that you would like to send your drawing.



- A email will be sent to that person and she will be able to open and view your drawing after clicking on the link.



- The link will take her directly to the drawing and she will be able to view it and make comments in the chat area. You will be able to view what she has drawn on your drawing and what comments she has made about your drawing. This is a great tool for input and collaboration!



10. You will be able to communicate with the person who has opened up the link to your drawing immediately.
11. You have now experienced teaching a lesson through Dabbleboard.
12. At this time, you can save your drawing if you have an account or make a screen shot of it to keep for your class. Once you log off the site, the drawing will be lost.
